

COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES FOR CURRENT GRADE 11 STUDENTS

- ✓ Students are required to take Grade 12 English.
- ✓ Students need to ensure all compulsory requirements are achieved including Groups 1, 2 and 3 credits.
- ✓ The Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements are listed on the Cameron Heights Course Calendar.
- ✓ If a student was unsuccessful on the Ontario Secondary School Literacy test – the student should select the Ontario Literacy Course (OLC4OI).
- ✓ Students must complete 40 hours of community service hours before June of their graduating year.
- ✓ All students are strongly encouraged to select 7 or 8 courses for grade 12 however, if a student has earned 24 credits by the end of grade 11, the student may choose to take 6 courses.
- ✓ When selecting courses, students should note the prerequisites for senior courses as listed in the Course Calendar.
- ✓ Please complete the Educational Planner form found in the Course Calendar **prior to entering their course selections.**
