

COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES FOR CURRENT GRADE 11 - FULL DIPLOMA IB STUDENTS



- ✓ Students need to ensure all compulsory and group requirements are met for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma
- ✓ Please remember that IB courses are identified by the sixth character “W” in the course code

Full diploma students should select the following courses:

1. ENG4UW (English)
2. ETS4UW (English)
3. FSF4UW (French) **OR** LWSDUW (Spanish)
4. SBI4UW (Biology) **OR** SCH4UW (Chemistry)
5. CHI4UW (History) **OR** HSB4UW (Psychology)
6. IDC4UW (IB Biology/Chemistry/History/Psychology)
7. Mathematics Analysis and Approaches (SL) – both MCV4UW and MHF4UW

Note for IB Certificate (Partial) Students:

- select IDC4UH if you are pursuing a History certificate only
- select IDC4UB if you are pursuing a Biology certificate only
- select IDC4US if you are pursuing a Chemistry certificate only
- select IDC4UP if you are pursuing a Psychology certificate only
- select IDC4UW if you are pursuing both History/Psychology and Biology/Chemistry certificates
- students will be granted only one credit for an IDC4U course -e.g. IDC4UW (IB), IDC4UX (Leadership). The highest mark achieved in any of these courses will be the one reported on the O.S.S. transcript.

Note for full diploma students:

- ✓ Students in the full IB diploma program will automatically have GPP3OW (C.A.S.) added to their timetable after the course selection process is completed. Students should **NOT** pick this course on My Way.
