

COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES FOR CURRENT GRADE 9 – IB STUDENTS



- ✓ Students need to ensure all compulsory and group requirements are met for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma.
- ✓ Students interested in pursuing a Cameron International Studies Certificate should review requirements in the CHCI Course Calendar.
- ✓ Please remember that IB courses are identified by the sixth character “W” in the course code.

A. Students must select the following courses:

1. ENG2DW (Gr. 10 English)
2. SNC2DW (Gr. 10 Science)
3. CHC2DW (Gr. 10 History)
4. MPM2DW – Mathematics (SL) or MPM2DX – Math Studies (SL) (Gr. 10 Math)
5. GLC2OH (Career Studies) and CHV2OH (Civics)

B. Language option: students who wish to pursue IB French will be required to take FSF2DW (Gr.10 French) and those students pursuing IB Spanish will begin studying Spanish in grade 11.

C. **Full Diploma IB students MAY TAKE ONLY TWO IB SCIENCES.** If you wish a third science, take the Ontario science option in grade 10:

- SBI3UI (Gr.11 Biology)
- SCH3UI (Gr.11 Chemistry)
- SPH3UI (Gr.11 Physics)

D. Any remaining spots you have are electives. Be sure you are meeting all Ontario Diploma requirements.
